### FROM M25 (CLOCKWISE)

Leave the M25 at J16 and join the M40 heading towards London. Exit the M40 at J1. At the traffic lights at the bottom of the slip road turn left onto the A40. Continue on the A40 for 1.5 miles until you come to the second traffic light junction. Turn right onto the A413 and continue for 2.5 miles. Continue straight over the first roundabout and then at the next, take the first exit into High Street (see inset).

### FROM M25 (ANTI-CLOCKWISE)

Leave the M25 at J18 and join the A404 towards Amersham. Continue straight through Chorleywood with the golf course on your left. Proceed into Little Chalfont and shortly past the railway station you will reach a roundabout. Turn left onto the B4442 Coke's Lane. Continue for 2.5 miles until you come to a roundabout opposite The Pheasant Inn. Turn left onto the A413 London Rd which becomes Gravel Hill leading into Chalfont St. Peter (see inset).

### FROM M40 (OXFORD)

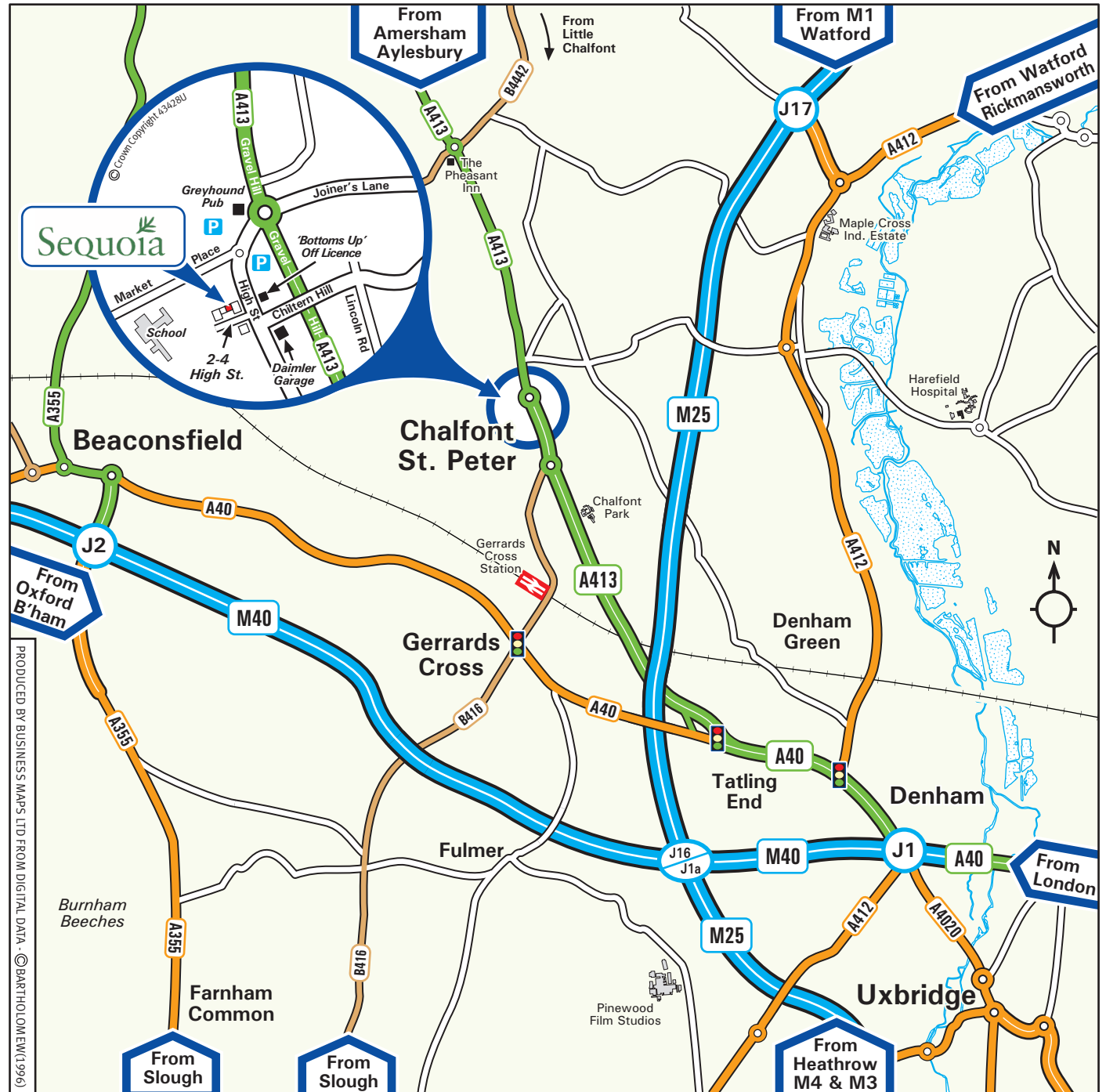
Leave the M40 at J2. At the top of the slip road turn left onto the A355. At the roundabout take the second exit onto the A40. Continue on the A40 for 3.3 miles and turn left at the traffic light junction on the B416. Continue on the B416 through Gerrards Cross for 1.5 miles. At the bottom of the hill turn left into Lower Road immediately before a roundabout. Lower Road becomes High Street after half a mile (see inset).

### FROM A40 (LONDON)

Follow the A40 (not joining the M40) to the traffic light junction with the A413. Turn right onto the A413 and continue for 2.5 miles. Continue straight over the first roundabout and then at the next, take the first exit into High Street (see inset).

### BY TRAIN

Gerrards Cross station is only a five minute journey from our offices and is on the main line between London Marylebone and Birmingham. Taxis are available from outside the station. For more information on train times and fares please call the National Rail Enquiry Line on 08457 48 49 50.
